



How to Reach MedILS

By airplane

During the summer months, there are direct flights from most European cities to Split airport (SPU). Split is regularly served by Croatia Airlines, Adria Airways, MALEV, CSA, and British Airways. Additional tourist charter flights are also available during summer.

In winter, or if no direct flight to Split is available, your best option might be to fly through Zagreb or Vienna. If you are traveling from overseas you will have to make an (additional) connection in one of the large European hubs, such as Frankfurt, London, Paris, or Zurich.

Split airport is located about half an hour to 45 minutes (depending on traffic) outside Split, near the town of Trogir (see map 1).

In order to reach MedILS from the airport, you have the following options:

1. A Taxi directly to MedILS (address below) will cost about 30 Euros or 210 kn.
2. Croatia airlines “PLESO – PRIJEVOZ” buses run from the airport to the city center every 20 minutes (www.plesoprijevoz.hr). A one-way ticket costs 30 kn. In addition, the regular town buses also run from the airport to the city center every 20 minutes (www.promet-split.hr). These buses will take you to the bus terminal on the east end of Riva (see map 2). You can then walk across Riva to the west end and from there, take the Bus Nr. 12, direction “Meje-Bene”, until “Villa Dalmacija – MedILS” (see map 2). Buses run once an hour and depart from Sv. Frane (west end of Riva) ten minutes before the hour. A ticket costs less than 10 kn.

By train

Split can be reached by train from Zagreb and other Croatian cities. The train station is conveniently located next to the bus terminal and the ferry port on the east end of Riva and the old town (see map 2). You can then walk across Riva to the west end and from there, take the Bus Nr. 12, direction “Meje-Bene”, until “Villa Dalmacija – MedILS” (see map 2). Buses run once an hour and depart from Sv. Frane (west end of Riva) ten minutes before the hour. A ticket costs less than 10 kn.

By bus

Split can be reached by coach from most Croatian cities as well as from the surrounding countries. Long-distance coaches from major European cities such as Munich, Zurich, Vienna, or Frankfurt are also available. The Split bus terminal is conveniently located next to the train station and the ferry port on the east end of Riva and the old town (see map 2). You can then walk across Riva to the west end and from there, take the Bus Nr. 12, direction “Meje-Bene”, until “Villa Dalmacija – MedILS” (see map 2). Buses run once an hour and depart from Sv. Frane (west end of Riva) ten minutes before the hour. A ticket costs less than 10 kn.


By boat/ferry

Split can be reached by ferry from the islands of Brac, Hvar, Korcula, Vis, and Solta, as well as from the ports of Zadar and Dubrovnik, and the Italian ports of Ancona and Pescara. Time tables vary depending on the time of the year and the day of the week. Please check the web page of the ferry line (Jadrolinija: <http://www.jadrolinija.hr>; Blue line: <http://www.blueline-ferries.com>; SNAV: <http://www.snav.it>). The Split ferry port is conveniently located next to the train station and the bus terminal on the east end of Riva and the old town (see map 2). You can then walk across Riva to the west end and from there, take the Bus Nr. 12, direction “Meje-Bene”, until “Villa Dalmacija – MedILS” (see map 2). Buses run once an hour and depart from Sv. Frane (west end of Riva) ten minutes before the hour. A ticket costs less than 10 kn.


By car

Split can be reached by car from the north on freeway E65/A1 from Zagreb, Rijeka, and Zadar. From the south, Split can be reached along the coastal road from Dubrovnik and Makarska (see map 3).

Once you are inside Split, go toward “Marjan” or “Meje”. You will have to cross a tunnel. After the tunnel, turn right onto Mestrovicevo setaliste (see map 4). The entrance to MedILS will be on your left after about 1km. There is a road sign indicating the entrance to MedILS.
